REMEMBERING AND FORGETTING

Sometimes it is nice to remember the past.

The English word "remember" occurs 166 times in the Bible. And so it is clear that God wants us to remember things although in our remembering we must not dwell on the past because we don't live there. We live in the here and now.

The Apostle Paul states: "forgetting what is behind and straining toward what is ahead." (Philippians 3:13). Paul had to forget his former life as a Jew and forget his past as a persecutor of the church; forget his former dreams. But his forgetting allowed him to "strain for what was ahead." If he had dwelled on his past, he would linger in hurt which would have diminished his effectiveness to live in the here and now.



We are all called to live Today; in the here and now!! Hebrews 3:13 says "But exhort one another every day, as long as it is called 'today', that none of you may be hardened by the deceitfulness of sin."
